

## Announcement of appeal<sup>1</sup>

## Background to the appeal

The Appellant's registration dossier for sodium hydrogen N-(1-oxotetradecyl)-L-glutamate (EC number 253-981-4, CAS number 38517-37-2) included a proposal to perform a pre-natal developmental toxicity study (EU B.31./OECD test guideline ('TG') 414), using an analogue substance, instead of a screening study (OECD TG 421/422).

On 20 January 2021, the Agency adopted the Contested Decision rejecting the Appellant's testing proposal.

On 13 April 2021, the Appellant filed an appeal against the Contested Decision. The Appellant requested the Board of Appeal to suspend the Contested Decision until it had updated its registration dossier with additional information to support its adaptation proposals and the Agency had evaluated those proposals.

The Appellant supported its appeal with pleas in law related to Articles 13 and 25 of the REACH Regulation. The Appellant argued that, under those provisions of the REACH Regulation, registrants are obliged wherever possible to generate information by means other than animal tests and to undertake animal testing only as a last resort.

On 5 May 2021, the Appellant withdrew the appeal. The case was therefore closed by the Chairman of the Board of Appeal on 19 May 2021 in accordance with Article 1b of Regulation (EC) No 771/2008.
