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### **On an authorisation of PROPASTA through mutual recognition in Latvia**

Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre (LEGMC) has evaluated an application submitted by **ARMOSA TECH SA** on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2020 concerning an authorisation of **PROPASTA** through mutual recognition in sequence.

LEGMC has agreed with Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics for **PROPASTA** developed by the reference Member State – Ireland.

Therefore, in accordance with Article 33 of *Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products* (regulation 528/2012) LEGMC authorises the **PROPASTA** on the basis of mutual recognition process.

The authorisation holder for **PROPASTA** in Latvia is:

**ARMOSA TECH SA**

Additional trade name for **PROPASTA** in Latvia is:

– *STRONG PASTA*.

**PROPASTA** contains **0.004 % (w/w)** of brodifacoum (CAS No. 56073-10-0; EC No. 259-980-5) as active substance.

**LEGMC assigns the authorisation number for biocidal product PROPASTA:**

**LV/2021/MR/011**

**The authorisation is valid until 25<sup>th</sup> April 2023.**

The authorisation number shall be indicated on the label of the biocidal product.

The authorisation of **PROPASTA** through mutual recognition is granted on the following terms:

- Product type: 14 – Rodenticides;
- Target organism – house mice (*Mus musculus*) and brown rat (*Rattus norvegicus*);
- Users: trained professionals and professionals;
- Product description: Ready-to-use bait - paste;
- Product stability: shelf life – 2 years;

- Use area: indoors, outdoors around buildings and outdoor open areas & waste dumps.

The authorisation through mutual recognition applies only to the biocidal product **PROPASTA** in the composition, form and packing material for which the first authorisation is granted by reference Member State.

The information on the label (and if applicable an enclosed instruction of use) of the **PROPASTA** should be as it is indicated in the first authorisation of above mentioned biocidal product, taking into account also the information which is stated in the Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics issued by reference Member State.

The information on the label shall be in Latvian.

Notwithstanding content of the label specified above, requirements stated in:

- Article 69 of *regulation 528/2012*,
- *Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of the substances and mixtures, amending and repealing Directives 67/548/EEC and 1999/45/EC, and amending Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006*,
- all other relevant legislation shall be applied.

ARMOSA TECH SA as the authorisation holder shall inform LEGMC about any changes in accordance with *Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 354/2013 of 18<sup>th</sup> April 2013 on changes of biocidal products authorised in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council*.

If the first authorisation issued by reference Member State is amended or revoked, the authorisation of **PROPASTA** through mutual recognition may be re-opened for review before the 25<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

Additionally, LEGMC would like to inform that ARMOSA TECH SA is fully responsible of the content of the biocidal product **PROPASTA** as well as its classification, labelling, instruction of use and safety data sheet.

LEGMC would like to ask ARMOSA TECH SA to notify the above mentioned information down to supply chain.
