	There is an on-going compliance check process (CCH) under which information relevant to clarify the initial concerns for PBT and reproductive toxicity was requested. It is expected that once obtained, the requested information could clarify the above-mentioned concerns. Furthermore, 1,1,3,5,5,5-heptamethyltrisiloxane (H-L3) is structurally closely related to octamethyltrisiloxane (L3, Cas no. 107-51-7). L3 has been conluded to meet the vPvB criteria following a recently finalized substance evaluation and data on this substance can be used in a read across approach for H-L3.
	In case the above mentioned concerns will not be (sufficiently) clarified by the information requested under CCH, the substance may be included in CoRAP again at the later stage.
