| | A compliance check was conducted by ECHA prior to the proposed substance evaluation for amines, C12-14 (even numbered)-alkyldimethyl, N-oxides. ECHA issued a compliance check decision in July 2017 requesting a pre-natal developmental toxicity study (OECD TG 414) in a second species and an extended one-generation reproductive toxicity study (OECD TG 443). The IE CA considers that the information provided in response to this compliance check decision addresses the initial concern for reproductive toxicity identified in the CoRAP justification document. In addition, the IE CA reviewed the available repeated dose toxicity studies and considers that the available data clarifies the initial concern for effects in the eyes also identified in the CoRAP justification document. Therefore, it is concluded that substance evaluation is no longer required. The substance is considered low priority for further regulatory action at this time. |
