# SCIP Prototype

- Will be release to the public
- The prototype will include the same **functionalities** that you have in the Beta environment.
- **Submitted data** will be considered **test data** and will be deleted (before the October release).
- **Submitted test data will not be made public**

- **New SCIP Webpage** update
  - Complete information about the prototype
  - New supporting materials

- **SCIP Webinar** coming soon: 17 March

Release of SCIP v1  
(planned for end of **October 2020**)  
Open to received data to fulfil legal obligation

# Next steps SCIP IT implementation

- Beta environment open until October
- Implementation of **improvements**:  
We will keep you updated of major improvements available on your test environment.
- Key features to be developed – focus is on **promoting reuse of data**
  - Allow referencing to data previously submitted
    - Redistribution module (distributors) (RDM)
    - Assemblers perspective (“referencing”)
  - Sharing article datasets amongst duty holders within supply chains
- Analysis of **dissemination portal**

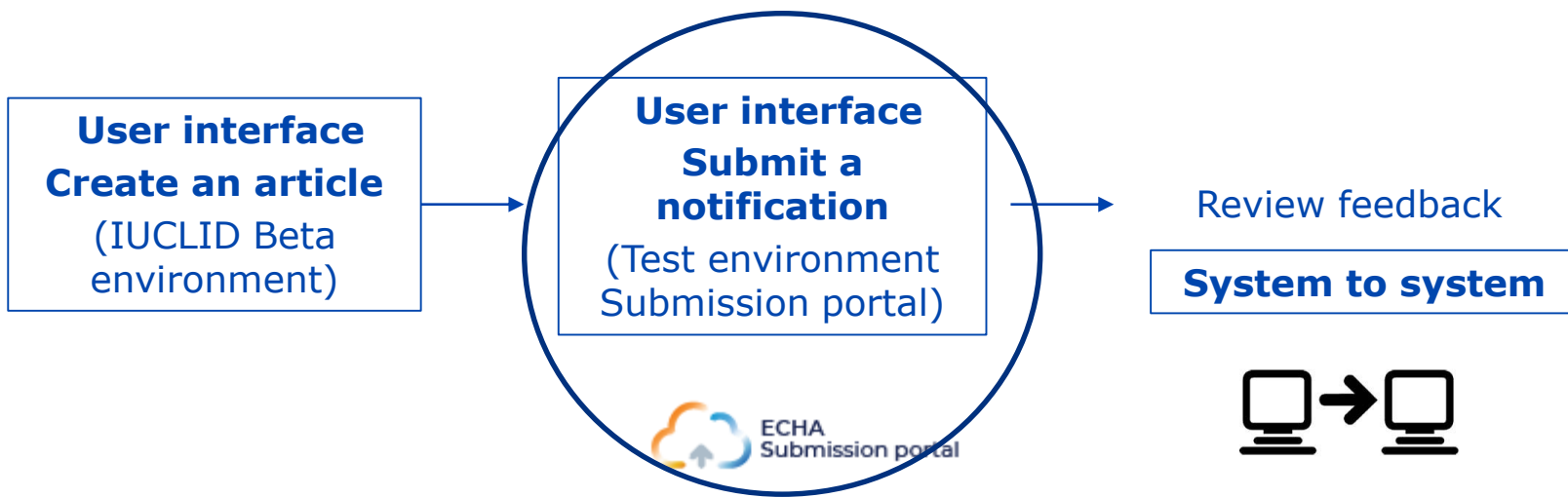

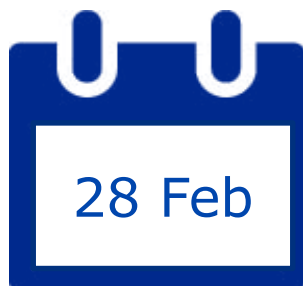
