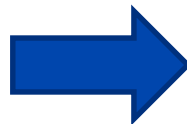

Material category: other

Material Category selection of Other is valid in the pick list as 1342 other; however it gets rejected by validation.



If the user selects 'other' as material category, additional information needs to be included in the "Other value".

Could the material category include other categories like: '**Subassembly and Electronic Parts as categories**'. We don't collect the level of detail required by current material categories.



Subassembly / electronic parts are not a material category/subcategory. The expectation is that you provide the information you have available about the material(s) the component articles are made of. If the information available does not allow you to select an existing item from the list, then select 'other' and include the information you have at the moment about the material .

Material category: Composite materials

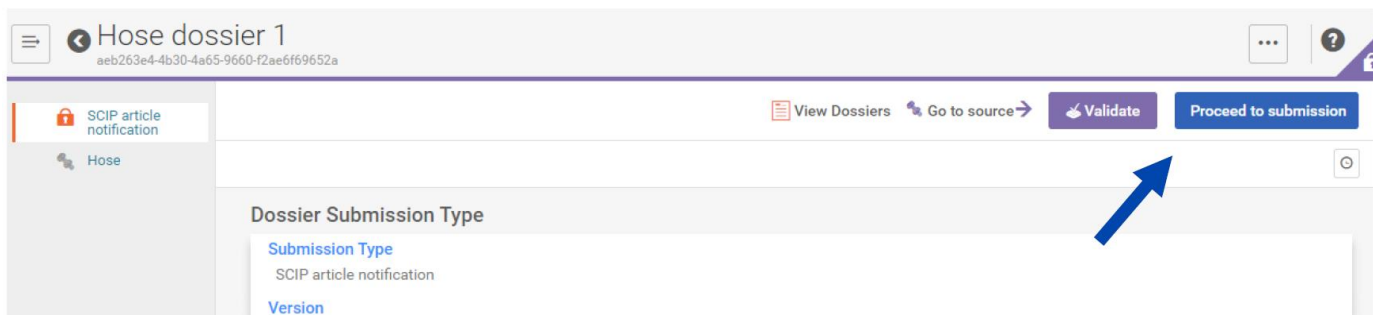
We don't collect the level of detail required by current material categories, and electronics are a blend of several categories. For example the resistor. Individual resistors are made of or contain carbon, ceramics, metals, plastics.



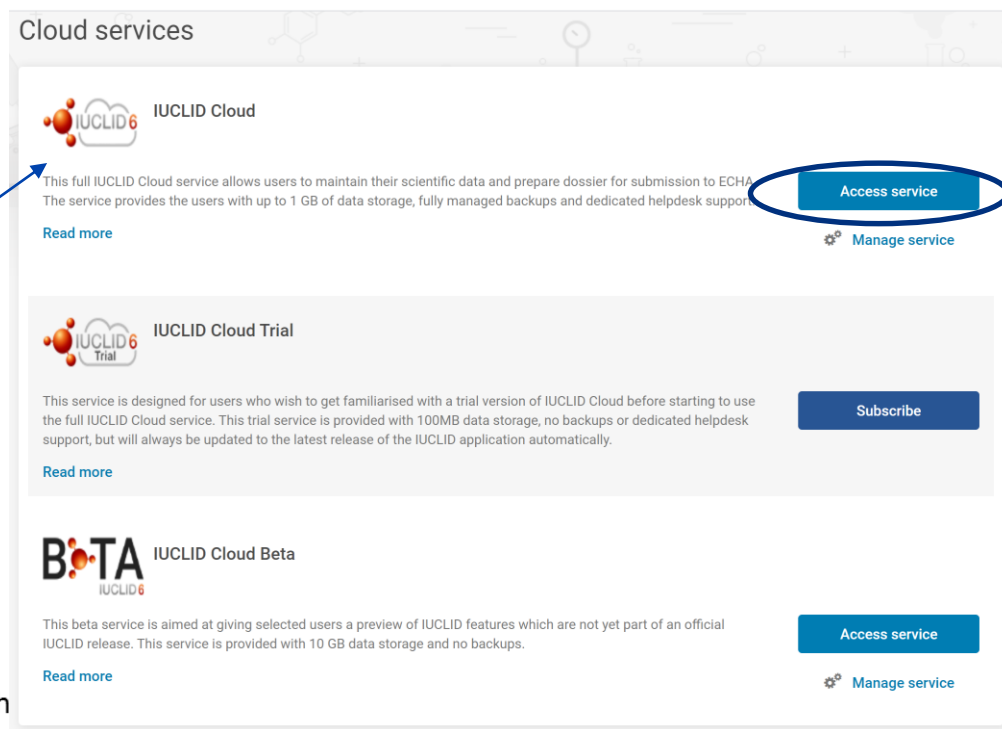
If you do not collect the information at the moment at the level of detail required, you can report what is available to you under 'other'. However, we recommend you to do so in the future.

Composite materials should be reported by selecting the basic material categories/subcategories the article is made of, and by selecting each basic material from the 'additional material characteristics', the option "composite material".

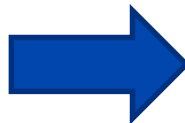

Reuse of SCIP data: Under analysis

- “Simplified SCIP notifications”: if an article is not changed, the duty holder can refer to data submitted by his supplier (e.g. useful for distributors)
- “Referencing”: refer to articles already notified by a supplier and now incorporated into complex objects by a producer

What if I am an articles supplier from outside of the EU? ([Q&A 1610](#))

- **Companies outside of the EU** are **not** allowed to submit SCIP notifications.
- ECHA will **allow non EU** companies to have **S2S key** for **testing purpose only.**
- EU importer may set up contractual agreements with their non-EU suppliers of articles to act on their behalf (as a 'foreign user'), regarding the submission of data to the SCIP database. However, the responsibility of the SCIP notification and its content still lies with the EU importer of articles. Please be aware that the third party users ('foreign user') will see the same information as all other users in the ECHA IT Tools.

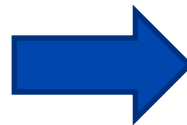
Users and dossier of large companies

- Can a parent company (legal entity) notify ECHA on a product, which is placed on the market by a subsidiary legal entity?
- Can one single user be delegate for multiple legal entities?



'foreign user'
is an external user from company B who has been appointed by the Legal Entity manager from company A to work for company A. A foreign user can perform actions on behalf of the company that grants him permission to use an account from their own ECHA account. (Q&A [960](#) and the [ECHA Accounts Manual](#)).

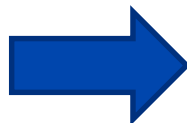
- Can one dataset be mapped to multiple legal entities? Can one dossier be mapped to multiple legal entities?



The same dossier can be sent by different LE. In the future "Simplified SCIP notification" or 'Referencing' can be used to avoid resending the same dossier twice.

S2S question

The Developer's Guide on p. 5 says that the *.xsl and *.css files are not required for import to ECHA." Since we will be automatically preparing the i6z rather than typing in the IUCLID client, please clarify this applies to SCIP submissions. This will greatly reduce the reporting burden and size of the dossiers by requiring only the .i6d data and manifest.xml.



We confirm .xsl and .css are not needed to be sent.
