R4BP 3.15 and SPC 2.5 release note

Below you can find the new functionalities that have been introduced in the release R4BP 3 3.15 and in the new SPC version 2.5.

New case types

- AA-AAT amendment of Article 95 asset (authority initiated)
- AA-UPD post approval update of scientific information for Article 95 assets (submitted with dossiers)

Enhancements relevant for both authorities and industry

- A new icon reports on the read/unread status of messages in the panel of R4BP 3 home page
- The "Archive" tag has been revised in the messages panel, making it Legal Entity specific
- The SPC option has been included in NA-RNL application and resubmit task
- The National authorisation transfer link expires when there is a positive/negative decision on the transfer
- The case and asset documents tab in R4BP 3 has been enhanced: it is now possible to search and filter documents
- A new layout of the ad-hoc communication interface has been developed for the TO & CC Recipients lists
- The visibility of delegations/ nominations/ transfers in R4BP 3 has been enhanced
- The "Valid from" filter has been added in the search engine

Enhancements relevant for industry

- The expiration date filed has been introduced for Article 95 assets. This feature is intended to prepare the structure to link the Article 95 R4BP 3 assets with the dissemination website in the future, by establishing a link between the Article 95 asset with the validity of the relevant Active substance or Annex I category 6 assets. It is currently introduced by default as an empty field, which might be populated by the industry applicant or authority via amendment case type (AA-AAT or AA-ADC). If the validity is not populated, the asset will not expire.
- In the PA-CHG case type is now possible to launch multiple join and replace cases
- When applying for SN/SA case types, R4BP 3 provides a SPC Validation message to inform
 if the selected Active Substances is not part of the Annex I list, and consequently
 preventing the submission

Enhancements relevant for authorities

- A communication message and an email notification are sent to MSCA when an applicant resubmits in the context of a case
- When a Simplified Authorisation asset is cancelled, a message is sent to the Competent Authorities where there is a notification (SN)
- Authorities are now able to update the validity period for expired assets, by making them active again
- The MSCA Validation task item has been removed in the AS-RNL process
- The cancellation of Simplified Authorisation (SA-CAT) initiation task will be limited to evaluating Competent Authority

SPC enhancements

- The code of the SPC language is now available in the cover page of PDF and Word SPC print out
- The market area name is reported at trade name level, but clearly separated
- Headings at target organisms level are introduced in the PDF and Word SPCs to flag the type of name introduced
- Decimal numbers are now marked with commas in PDF and Word SPC versions
- Standard phrases are introduced in the draft Word SPC for marking an expected prospective asset number, and MetaSPC suffix for product family SPCs
- Only first level headings are displayed in the SPC PDF Table of Contents
