<p><i>The initial ground of concern as suspected PBT has been evaluated. The screening criterion for P/vP is met, however the degradation simulation studies, needed to investigate the persistence, are standard information at the substance tonnage band, which should be requested under compliance check. Nevertheless, most of the constituents are volatile or highly volatile, condition that impairs the technical feasibility of the simulation tests.</i></p> <p><i>Based on the measured Pow and QSAR predictions, the main constituent (Diisopropylether) and the other minor constituents that are not readily biodegradable, are not expected to be bioaccumulative, as well as their potential degradation products. Moreover, the fish bioaccumulation study required at this tonnage band is a standard information.</i></p> <p><i>Therefore, the substance does not pose PBT/vPvB concerns.</i></p>
