On the renewal of authorisation for Protect Sensation

Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre (LEGMC) received an application submitted by **Bábolna Bioenvironmental Centre Ltd.** on the 29th July 2019 for renewal of national authorisation in accordance with Article 31(1) of *Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products* for **Protect Sensation** (authorisation number: **LV/2018/MR/004**) through Biocidal Product Register.

LEGMC has agreed with Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics **Protect Sensation** developed by the reference Member States – France.

Therefore, in accordance with Article 5 of the *Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 492/2014 of 7 March 2014 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the rules for renewal of authorisation of biocidal products subject to mutual recognition* the authorisation for **Protect Sensation** is renewed and is valid until **17 January 2026**.

Protect Sensation contains 0.005% of bromadiolone (CAS No. 28772-56-7; EC No. 249-205-9) and is renewed on the following terms:

- Product type: 14 – Rodenticide;
- Target organisms: house mice (*Mus musculus*), brown rats (*Rattus norvegicus*) and black or roof rat (*Rattus rattus*);
- Users: trained professional and professional;
- Product description: ready-to-use bait - block;
- Product stability: shelf life 2 years;
- Use area: indoors and outdoors around buildings.

This letter is integral part of authorisation letter (No. 4-6/303) issued by LEGMC on the 1st of March 2018.

LEGMC would like to ask **Bábolna Bioenvironmental Centre Ltd.** to notify the above mentioned information down to supply chain.
