Preliminary conclusions 74th Management Board Meeting

19 June 2024 via remote connection

1. Opinion on the final accounts 2023

The Management Board adopted its opinion on ECHA's final accounts for the financial year 2023, taking into account the draft annual report of the European Court of Auditors and the recommendation made by its Subgroup Finance, Audit and Risks.

2. ECHA Committees

4. Implementing Rules to the Staff Regulations

The Management Board adopted a decision to request the European Commission's agreement to derogate from the Commission Decision C(2023) 8630 of 12.12.2023 on the prevention of and fight against psychological and sexual harassment in view of adopting different rules and adopted a decision to apply by analogy the Commission Decision C(2024) 1038 amending Commission Decision C(2011)1278 of 3 March 2011 on the general implementing provisions for Articles 11 and 12 of Annex VIII to the Staff Regulations on the transfer of pension rights.
