On an authorisation of the biocidal product FERGRANO BRODI 25

Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre (LEGMC) has evaluated an application submitted by **FERBI S.r.l.** on 20th January 2020 concerning an authorisation of **FERGRANO BRODI 25** through mutual recognition in sequence.

LEGMC has agreed with Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics developed by the reference Member States – France.

Therefore, in accordance with Article 33 of *Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products* (Regulation (EU) No 528/2012), LEGMC authorises the FERGRANO BRODI 25 on the basis of mutual recognition process.

FERGRANO BRODI 25 contains **0.0025%** of *brodifacoum* (CAS No. 56073-10-0, EC No. 259-980-5) as an active substance.

LEGMC assigns the authorisation number **LV/2020/MR/001**.

The authorisation number shall be indicated on the label of the biocidal product.

The authorisation is valid until **9 October 2024**.

- *APTIRAT GRAIN*;
- *BRODIFAST GRAIN*;
- *ENDERAT GRAIN*;
- *FIGHTER GRAIN*;
- *IKURAT GRAIN*.

The authorisation holder is **FERBI S.r.l.**

The authorisation is granted on the following terms:

- Product type: 14 – rodenticide;
- Target organism: house mouse, brown rat and roof rat;
- Users: non-professional (general public), professional and trained professional;
- Product description: ready to use bait (grain);
- Product stability: 24 months;

- Field of use – as indicated in Summary of Product Characteristics depend on users and target organisms;
- Pack sizes and packaging material: as indicated in Summary of Product Characteristics depend on users and target organisms.

The authorisation through mutual recognition applies only to the product FERGRANO BRODI 25 in the composition, form and packing for which the first authorisation is granted by reference Member State.

The information on the label (and if applicable an enclosed instruction of use) should be as it is indicated in the first authorisation of above mentioned product, taking into account also the information which is stated in the Product Assessment Report and Summary of Product Characteristics issued by reference Member State.

The information on the label shall be in Latvian.

Notwithstanding content of the label specified above, requirements stated in:

- *Article 69 Regulation (EU) No 528/2012;*
- *Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of the substances and mixtures, amending and repealing Directives 67/548/EEC and 1999/45/EC, and amending Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006;*
- all other relevant legislation shall be applied.

FERBI S.r.l. shall inform LEGMC about any changes in accordance with *Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 354/2013 of 18th April 2013 on changes of biocidal products authorised in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council.*

If the first authorisation issued by reference Member State is amended or revoked, the authorisation of FERGRANO BRODI 25 through mutual recognition may be re-opened for review before 9th October 2024.

Application on renewal of an authorisation shall be submitted according to *Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 492/2014 of 7 March 2014 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the rules for the renewal of authorisations of biocidal products subject to mutual recognition.*

Additionally LEGMC would like to inform that FERBI S.r.l. is fully responsible of the content of the biocidal product FERGRANO BRODI 25 as well as its classification, labelling, instruction of use and safety data sheet.

LEGMC would like to ask FERBI S.r.l. to notify the above mentioned information down to supply chain.
